## A BILL

To authorize the Peace Corps Commemorative Foundation to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MEMORIAL TO COMMEMORATE THE ESTAB-**  
4 **LISHMENT OF THE PEACE CORPS AND TO**  
5 **HONOR THE IDEALS UPON WHICH IT WAS**  
6 **FOUNDED.**

7 (a) AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORA-  
8 TIVE WORK.—The Peace Corps Commemorative Founda-  
9 tion may establish a commemorative work on Federal land

1 in the District of Columbia and its environs to commemo-  
2 rate the formation of the Peace Corps and to honor the  
3 ideals upon which the Peace Corps was founded.

4 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-  
5 RATIVE WORKS ACT.—The establishment of the com-  
6 memorative work shall be in accordance with chapter 89  
7 of title 40, United States Code (commonly known as the  
8 “Commemorative Works Act”).

9 (c) USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS PROHIBITED.—Federal  
10 funds may not be used to pay any expense of the establish-  
11 ment of the commemorative work. The Peace Corps Com-  
12 memorative Foundation shall be solely responsible for ac-  
13 ceptance of contributions for, and payment of the expenses  
14 of, the establishment of the commemorative work.

15 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—If, upon payment  
16 of all expenses for the establishment of the commemora-  
17 tive work (including the maintenance and preservation  
18 amount required by section 8906(b) of title 40, United  
19 States Code), or upon expiration of the authority for the  
20 commemorative work under section 8903(e) of title 40,  
21 United States Code, there remains a balance of funds re-  
22 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative work,  
23 the Peace Corps Commemorative Foundation shall trans-  
24 mit the amount of the balance to the Secretary of the

- 2 8906(b)(1) of title 40, United States Code.
