Unfortunately, this legislation does nothing to address the deficit crisis, and will only leave the next generation further in debt. I remain worried for the future of our country, and I will not let down my commitment to change the federal government's out-of-control spending habits.

We all knew that the fiscal cliff was looming, and yet, nothing was done until the final moments of this year. House Republicans passed legislation this past summer that would have allowed the entire saga to be avoided.
