This week, Congress passed a Continuing Resolution to fund the government for the next four weeks.

A Continuing Resolution simply keeps the government open, but at last year's funding level. Plus, there is no way for the government to efficiently contract with suppliers. Authorizing appropriations is a power vested in Congress. We must not delay our responsibility to budget and provide funding for the federal government.

Instead of taking the time to focus on what Americans need, Congress, as you know, is prioritizing non-legislative activities. Congress has allowed itself to be held hostage by partisan games to gain political leverage.
