

Dr. Burgess Weekly Video Address September 11, 2015 “Iran Nuclear Agreement”

Hello, this is your Congressman, Michael Burgess. As you have probably seen in the news as Congress gets back to work this week, we prepare to vote on one of the most important foreign policy and national security issues in more than a decade.

The Iran Nuclear Agreement has caused great concern in Washington and fear across the nation.

This deal means the lifting of sanctions on Iran that would result in billions of dollars of relief for the country. We would be responsible for allowing Iran’s extremist government to continue its reckless foreign policy agenda.

This isn’t a deal. This is a gift to the mullahs in Iran.

I strongly oppose this agreement that would recognize and legitimize Iran’s nuclear program. The product of the negotiations with Iran pave the path toward a nuclear Iran. The greatest risk to our national security.

As we honor the 14th anniversary of the September 11th attacks on U.S. soil today, we must use the remembrance of that tragic day to reinforce why we do not reward state sponsors of terror with gifts such as this agreement. These sanctions were placed on Iran for a reason.

Also concerning is that the proposed deal is silent on the fate of the four Americans that are being held unjustly in Iran. We need a structured agreement that will demand the safe return home of these

hostages. Not an agreement that exonerates Iranians that are known to have killed hundreds of Americans.

I cannot support what has been outlined in the Iran agreement. A nuclear Tehran simply cannot be allowed to exist. As your Representative in Congress, I will continue fighting to ensure that Iran does not obtain a nuclear weapon.
